

By air or by road you will be treated to beautiful views and experiences to remember...

#### By air

Fly into Nelspruit or Skukuza

#### By road from the nearest town

Make your way for approximately & kilometres through the town of Komatipoort, rumoured to be one of the hottest towns in South Africa, towards the Crocodile Bridge gate (swimming not recommended), and you are officially in the Kruger National Park, one of Africa's largest game reserves. Travel for another 4 kilometres and until you cross the Vurhami Bridge (keep a look out for the big 5, they're out there). Keep a look out too for a right turn at the first Shishangeni Lodge (it says no entry road -things may get a bit bumpy until the next right turn at the second sign board for Shishangeni Lodge (it says no entry but you may drive through)! Continue for another 10 kilometres, which will take you straight to the lodge - you've arrived!
